**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to fire safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 81 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 13 by inserting the following after the words “twenty-
3 two.”:-

4 “Direct supervision” for the purpose of work on a fire protection sprinkler system shall
5 mean the physical on-site presence with the assigned apprentice and their supervising
6 journeyman or fire protection sprinkler contractor.”

7 SECTION 2. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
8 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 2 by striking the word “his” and inserting in place
9 thereof the following: “their”

10 SECTION 3. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
11 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 4 by striking the word “he” and inserting in place
12 thereof the following: “they”;

13 SECTION 4. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
14 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 6 by striking the word “his” and inserting in place
15 thereof the following: “their”;

16 SECTION 5. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
17 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 7 by striking the word “he is” and inserting in place
18 thereof the following: “they are”;

19 SECTION 6. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
20 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 7 by striking the word “his” and inserting in place
21 thereof the following: “their”;

22 SECTION 7. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
23 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 8 by striking the word “his” and inserting in place
24 thereof the following: “their”;

25 SECTION 8. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
26 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 10 by striking the word “him” and inserting in place
27 thereof the following: “them”;

28 SECTION 9. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
29 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 14 after the word “fitter.” the following:-

30 “Direct supervision” for the purposes of this section shall mean the physical on-site
31 presence with the assigned apprentice and their supervising journeyman or fire protection
32 sprinkler contractor while conducting work on a fire protection sprinkler system.”

33 SECTION 10. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
34 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the following in lines 14-16:-

35 “A fire protection sprinkler contractor may employ one or more apprentices but not more
36 than one apprentice may be so employed for each journeyman sprinkler fitter.”

37 SECTION 11. Section 85A of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
38 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 14 after the word “fitter” the following:-

39 “The ratio permitted shall be one licensed journeyman sprinkler fitter or fire protection sprinkler
40 contractor for every apprentice sprinkler fitter on the jobsite.”

41 SECTION 12. Section 89 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
42 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 4 after the word “eighty-one” by inserting the
43 following:- “including sections eighty-four through eighty-six,”.
