An Act relative to Mass Port police officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Editions,  
2 is hereby further amended by inserting in the description of Group 4 in paragraph (g) of  
3 subdivision (2), in line 268, after the words fire control men; the following:--- employees of the  
4 Massachusetts port authority who are employed as port officers and supervisors of said  
5 employees who shall include port sergeants, lieutenants, captains, assistant chiefs, deputy chiefs,  
6 directors;
