An Act related to timely retirement payment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (B) of subdivision (1) of Section 13 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws shall  
2 be amended by adding the following after the words “allowance becomes effective.”, the  
3 following words: - “In the event circumstances beyond the retirement board’s control prevent the  
4 calculation of the full monthly payment by the first such full payment date, the retirement board  
5 shall pay 90% of its estimated full monthly payment until such time as the circumstances beyond  
6 the retirement board’s control are corrected. On an annual basis, the retirement board will notify  
7 the House and the Senate of all circumstances beyond the retirement board’s control that  
8 prevented the calculation of the full monthly payment by the first such full payment date.”
