**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act eliminating post-retirement earnings restrictions for police detail work.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

3 (f) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a retired police officer
4 receiving a pension under this chapter who is employed by a city, town, or other municipal entity
5 to perform police details or other police-related duties shall not be subject to any limitation on
6 hours worked or compensation earned that would otherwise affect the retiree's pension benefits.
