An Act relative to certain licensed pipefitters and refrigeration technicians.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting in line 315, after the clause "employees of the Massachusetts Port  
3 Authority who are employed as licensed electricians, utility technicians, steam engineers, watch  
4 engineers, boiler operators," the following words:- "licensed pipefitters and refrigeration  
5 technicians,".
