An Act relative to further defining employees classified in Group 4.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the Generals Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting, in line 327, after the word “supervisor”, the following words:-  
3           associate probation officers, probation officer, assistance chief probation officer, senior  
4 community corrections probation officer, and day reporting center probation officer, first  
5 assistant chief probation officer, court officer I, court officer II, court officer III, assistant and  
6 chief court officer, associate court officer, and court officer-in-charge.
