Resolve authorizing the study of cost of living increases for state police retirees.

1 **Resolved**, Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall be a
2 special commission to examine the feasibility of increases to Cost of Living Adjustments for
3 retirees of the Massachusetts State Police. The commission shall consist of the chairs of the joint
4 committee on public service, the executive director of the state retirement board, a member to be
5 appointed by the chair of the MA public employee retirement administration commission and the
6 president of MA retirees.

7 Said commission shall report to the house and senate committees on ways and means the
8 results of its investigation recommendations together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
9 said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerks of the house of
10 representatives and senate on or before January 1, 2026.
