An Act relative to raising the entrance age of police officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 58A of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in line  
2   4 the words “position of firefighter or police officer if such person has reached his thirty-second  
3   birthday on the date of the entrance examination” and inserting in place thereof the following  
4   words:- , position of firefighter if such person has reached his thirty-second birthday and police  
5   officer if such person has reached his fortieth birthday on the date of the entrance examination.
