**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to Massachusetts certified emergency telecommunicators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32, Section 3, paragraph G, "Group 2" of the Massachusetts General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting in line 283 after the words "Cushing hospital" the following:-

3 "; and all full time Dispatchers, Dispatch Supervisors, Communications Center Directors
4 or Communications Chiefs certified by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts State 911
5 Department as Certified Telecommunicators as defined by MA 560 CMR 5.04".
