An Act to repeal the sales tax exemption for aircraft.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out subsections (uu) and (vv).
