- 1            Subsection (u) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2            Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 349, after the word “has” the following
- 3            words:- “been awarded permanent disability compensation by the United States Department of
- 4            Veterans Affairs at a 100% rating, or”.
