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An Act relative to ride share companies' customer service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 159A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following section:-

3 Section 33. Ride share companies, including but not limited to Uber and Lyft, shall  
4 maintain a customer service line 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
