**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act restoring commuter rail to Cape Cod.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Not later than 12 months after the effective date of this act, the MBTA shall begin
2 commuter passenger train service between Buzzards Bay station and South station via the Cape
3 Cod line. Train service shall occur year-round and, insofar as is feasible as determined by the
4 MBTA, schedules shall be aligned with the commuting patterns of the service areas. The MBTA
5 shall operate no fewer than three morning-peak trips and three evening-peak trips on this route
6 each weekday.
