**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to online driver education.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 32G of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting after line 239 the following sentence:-

3 The registrar may approve a driver education curriculum presented in a virtual instructor-
4 led format by a state-licensed driving school if the following conditions are met:- (a) the driving
5 school owns or leases physical offices and/or classrooms in the Commonwealth to provide in-
6 person instruction (b) the driving school has no less than three consecutive years of operation in
7 the Commonwealth (c) the driving school is in good standing with the Registry of Motor
8 Vehicles.
