Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary and any regulation, the board
2 of state examiners of electricians and board of electricians appeals shall promulgate regulations
3 to allow for a journeyman electrician to have no more than two apprentices under his or her
4 direct supervision or employ, provided that one of the apprentices is a student from an accredited
5 Chapter 74 Electricity program.
