*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 14B of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after the word “expense”, in line 32, the following words:- provided that all such
- 3 expenses shall be allocated evenly, relative to the number of attending students, among the towns
- 4 in such a district.
