*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 6B of chapter 159B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in the second paragraph, the number “35” and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the number “48”.
