In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to access for after school and out-of-school time programs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 7 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 63. (a) There shall be established an After School and Out-of-School Time
- 3 Opportunity Fund. The program shall be administered by the department of elementary and
- 4 secondary education. A qualified program eligible for funding is any out-of-school time program
- 5 that serves school age children and youth and is licensed by the department of early education
- 6 and care, or is license-exempt.
- 7 (b) The purpose of the fund shall be to support the establishment of and increase access to
- 8 and the quality of afterschool and out of school time programs. The fund shall consist of all
- 9 moneys received by the commonwealth equal to 3 percent of the receipts of the sales price of
- purchases received by all marijuana retailers as provided for in chapter 64N as excises paid to the

- 11 commissioner of revenue. Such amounts in the fund shall be administered by the department of 12 elementary and secondary education.
- 13 (c) The department shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement the 14 provisions of this section.
