An Act relative to public safety on private and public college and university campuses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 147 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,  
2 is amended by adding the following new paragraph:-

3 Section 64. Identification Cards

4 Notwithstanding any general or special law or regulation to the contrary, or their status as  
5 a special state police officer, all officers of law enforcement agencies shall be issued and entitled  
6 to possession of a Massachusetts police identification card by their law enforcement agency, as  
7 authorized by state and federal law, under the same terms and conditions as municipal police  
8 officers and University of Massachusetts police officers. For the purposes of this paragraph, law  
9 enforcement agencies shall mean public or private colleges, universities or other educational  
10 institutions.
