Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 94A of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the final paragraph the following new
- 3 paragraph:-
- 4 Notwithstanding anything set forth herein, the department shall not approve any contract
- 5 for the purchase of gas, gas pipeline capacity or liquefied gas storage where any contract costs
- 6 would be recoverable from the ratepayers, if such contract requires any construction or
- 7 expansion of interstate gas infrastructure.
