In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to the retirement of Greg Heath, a former firefighter of the city of Westfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 32 of the General Laws or any other general or
special law to the contrary the Westfield retirement board shall retire Greg Heath under section 7
of chapter 32 based upon any condition of impairment of health caused by Parkinson's Disease
which it determines was incurred as a result of his employment.

5 SECTION 2. The payments provided for in this act shall only be made after said member 6 has been examined by a medical panel, pursuant to section 6 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, 7 which has certified by a majority of the medical panel physicians that said member is mentally or 8 physically incapacitated from further duty, that such incapacity is likely to be permanent, and 9 that such incapacity is such as might be the natural and proximate result of Parkinson's Disease; 10 provided, however, that the public employee retirement administration commission may, upon 11 request, waive such medical panel examination if the member has previously been examined by

- 12 a medical panel and is receiving a disability benefit as of the effective date of this act. The
- 13 commission shall promptly notify the retirement system of such waiver.
- 14 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon September 26, 2020.
