In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act enhancing security in emergency housing programs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 30 of Chapter 23B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-
- 3 (H) The executive office shall conduct background checks on all applicants aged 18 and
- 4 older before admission into the Emergency Housing Assistance Program.
- 5 (a) Background checks shall include: (1) State and federal criminal history checks; (2)
- 6 Sex offender registry checks; (3) Verification of outstanding warrants or pending criminal
- 7 charges.
- 8 (b) The executive office shall coordinate with the department of criminal justice
- 9 information services, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, and the Federal Bureau of
- 10 Investigation to verify background information and immigration status.
- 11 (c) Applicants with pending charges or convictions for violent crimes, drug trafficking, or
- sex offenses shall be ineligible for program participation.

- 13 (d) The executive office shall promulgate regulations to implement and enforce this
- subsection.
