## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to the taxation of small business in the commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 32D of chapter 63 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the figure "\$6,000,000", each time it appears,
3	and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- "12,000,000"; and,
4	Said section is hereby further amended by striking out the figure "9,000,000"", each time
5	it appears, and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- "18,000,000".
6	SECTION 2. For the purposes of this section, the total receipts thresholds shall increase
7	by the percentage of the Consumer Price Index from the previous calendar year issued by the
8	federal Bureau of Labor Statistics or shall remain the same in the even of a decrease in the
9	Consumer Price Index.
