In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relating to public access to historical records.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws is hereby amended by

2 inserting at the end thereto the following sentence: All records in the custody of the state

3 secretary accessioned from state institutions for people with intellectual or developmental

4 disabilities or mental health conditions in the commonwealth shall be open to public inspection

5 and available for copying after the expiration of seventy-five years from creation of the record.
