## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to child passenger safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 7AA of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following paragraph:-
- 3 "A passenger in a motor vehicle on any way who is under the age of 13 shall not be
- 4 seated in the front passenger seat of a motor vehicle on any way unless: (i) the motor vehicle
- 5 does not have a rear passenger seat; or (ii) the rear passenger seat of the motor vehicle is
- 6 occupied by other passengers under the age of 13.".
