In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to concurrent jurisdiction on National Park Service properties.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 360 of the acts of 1984 is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after the word "lands", in lines 2 and 5, the word:- ", waters".
- 3 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 360 is hereby further amended by inserting at
- 4 the end thereof the following clause:-
- 5 (m) All lands, waters and buildings acquired, leased or administratively controlled by the

6 National Park Service on or after the effective date of this act.

- 7 SECTION 3. Section 2 of said chapter 360 of the acts of 1984 is hereby amended by
- 8 inserting at the end thereof the following:- Concurrent jurisdiction over any lands, waters or
- 9 buildings under clause (m) of section 1 shall vest in the United States of America when the

- 10 Director of the National Park Service files a notice of such acceptance with the governor and
- 11 state secretary.
