## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act requiring seat belts on school buses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 7B of chapter 90 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2022
  official edition, is hereby amended by adding after criteria (18) the following:- "(19) Every
  school bus transporting students to or from a public, vocational, private or parochial school shall
  be equipped with a seatbelt for each permanent seating accommodation designed and installed in
  compliance with United States motor vehicle D.O.T. safety standards."
- SECTION 2. A city or town may enact a local ordinance or bylaw requiring that school buses operating within the municipality must be equipped with seatbelts at an earlier implementation date.
  - SECTION 3. No claim for damages shall arise from the failure of a school bus operator, a school, school district or municipality to ensure that a passenger of a school bus was wearing the restraint system prescribed by Sections 7B of Chapter 90 of the general laws.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2028.
