An Act relative to motorcycle safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13D of Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in lines 22-23 by inserting the words "nationally 3 recognized" in front of the words "motorcycle awareness program" and in line 23, by striking the 4 words "Motorcycle Safety Foundation" and inserting in place thereof:- "Massachusetts 5 Motorcycle Rider Education Program". And by striking the following: Two dollars from each 6 motorcycle registration fee paid under Section 34 of Chapter 90 shall be used to fund the cost of 7 the required materials for the motorcycle awareness program module required by this section. 8 SECTION 2. Section 32G of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 9 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 203 by inserting the words "nationally recognized" in 10 front of the words "motorcycle awareness program" and in lines 204-205, by striking the words 11 "Motorcycle Safety Foundation" and inserting in place thereof the following words:-

- 12 "Massachusetts Motorcycle Rider Education Program". And by striking the following: Two
- 13 dollars from each motorcycle registration fee paid under Section 34 shall fund the cost of the
- 14 required materials for the motorcycle awareness program module required by this section.
