### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to the tracking of medical malpractice cases.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special to the contrary the administrator of 2 the trial court shall develop and implement a system to track and categorize any civil action 3 malpractice, error or mistake against a provider of health care. Annually by December 31 the 4 administrator of the trial court shall submit the number of any civil action malpractice, error or 5 mistake against a provider of health care to the clerks of the house and senate and the joint 6 committee on the judiciary.
