An Act eliminating education funding inflation cap.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 2 of Chapter 70 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 93 to 96, the words "the lesser of: (i) the ratio of the  
3 value of the implicit price deflator for state and local government purchases in the third quarter  
4 of the prior fiscal year to its value in the third quarter of the fiscal year 2 years prior; and (ii)  
5 1.045" and inserting in place thereof the following words: "the ratio of the value of the implicit  
6 price deflator for state and local government purchases in the third quarter of the prior fiscal year  
7 to its value in the third quarter of the fiscal year 2 years prior."
