In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act updating gateway municipalities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 23A of the General Laws is hereby amended in Section 3A by striking out"Gateway municipality", a municipality with a population greater than 35,000 and less
 than 250,000, a median household income below the commonwealth's average and a rate of
 educational attainment of a bachelor's degree or above that is below the commonwealth's
 average.

 and inserting the following-
- "Gateway municipality", a municipality with a population greater than 35,000 and less than 250,000, or two or more municipalities forming an inter-municipal agreement for this purpose with a combined population greater than 35,000 and less than 250,000, a median
