## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act enabling clean energy transition.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 16 of Chapter 25A of the General Laws as appearing in the 2024
- 2 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding at the end after subsection (f) the following
- 3 subsection:-
- 4 (g) The executive office of energy and environmental affairs shall promulgate standards
- 5 and regulations for cost disclosure at all public vehicle charging stations. The owner or operator
- of a public electric vehicle charging station or a designee shall place at each public charging
- 7 station where there is a cost to charge, a standardized cost disclosure notice based on the
- 8 aforementioned standards.
