An Act relative to ATV vehicles owned and operated by police and fire departments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 90B Section 25 as appearing in the 2022 edition is  
2 hereby amended by inserting at the end the following:--

3           "Provided that the Registry of Motor Vehicles shall provide registration and regulation  
4 for the allowance of recreational vehicles to be used on public roads and ways if such vehicles  
5 are owned and operated by Police or Fire departments for emergency response, provided further  
6 the Registry shall provide specialty plates denoting such vehicles as being owned and operated  
7 by Police or Fire departments."
