In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act codifying organizational standing to protect and promote civil rights.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 151B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 3, after the word "corporations", the
3	following words:-, public interest organizations.
4	SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 151B, as so appearing, is hereby further
5	amended by inserting after paragraph 23 the following paragraph:-
6	24. The term "public interest organization" shall mean any non-profit organization which
7	is organized or operating in whole or in part for the purpose of combating discrimination or bias,
8	of safeguarding civil rights or of promoting interests or rights under this chapter.
9	SECTION 3. Section 5 of said chapter 151B, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
10	inserting, after the first sentence, the following sentence:- Without limiting or excluding any
11	other basis for a complaint, a public interest organization may be aggrieved if a purpose or
12	activities to achieve that purpose were perceptively impaired by an alleged unlawful practice or
13	violation; or if an alleged unlawful practice or violation was directed at the public interest

organization or its agents or employees; or where the public interest organization has a sufficient nexus to the interests of the person or persons whose interests are harmed by an alleged unlawful practice or violation.

17 SECTION 4. Section 9 of chapter 151B, as so appearing, is hereby amended in the 18 second paragraph by inserting, after the first sentence, the following sentence:- Without limiting 19 or excluding any other basis for a civil action, a public interest organization may be aggrieved if 20 a purpose or activities to achieve that purpose were perceptively impaired by an alleged unlawful 21 practice; or if an alleged unlawful practice was directed at the public interest organization or its 22 agents or employees; or where the public interest organization has a sufficient nexus to the 23 interests of the person or persons whose interests are harmed by an alleged unlawful practice.
