### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to the use of drones by insurance companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 231.
- 4 (a) As used in this section, the following words shall have the following meanings unless
- 5 the context clearly requires otherwise:
- 6 "Drone", any remotely piloted aircraft or hovercraft.
- 7 "Policyholder", any individual who is (i) insured by a company, or (ii) attempting to
- 8 purchase insurance from a company.
- 9 (b) The division of insurance shall issue recommendations for regulating the use of
- 10 drones by companies for the purpose of determining eligibility of any policyholder, or
- 11 determining the price of insurance premiums for any policyholder.

12 The recommendations shall address areas including but not limited to: (a) requirements 13 for companies to notify policyholders about the use of drones for determining eligibility or 14 premium price; (b) requirements for companies to obtain consent of policyholders to use of 15 drones for determining eligibility or premium price; and (c) penalties for companies that illegally 16 or improperly use drones.
