An Act ensuring municipal access to state funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3A of Chapter 40A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out subsection (b) and inserting in place thereof the following subsection:
 (b) Notwithstanding any general or special law, regulation, or policy to the contrary, the executive office of housing and livable communities, in collaboration with the attorney general, shall not condition, restrict, or withhold eligibility for any state funding, grant, or financial
- 7 assistance including, but not limited to: (1) the MassWorks Infrastructure Program; (2)
- 8 Community Planning Grants; (3) the Massachusetts Downtown Initiative; (4) Urban Agenda
- 9 Grants; (5) the Rural and Small Town Development Fund; (6) the Brownfields Redevelopment
- Fund; (7) the Site Readiness Program; (8) the Underutilized Properties Program; (9) the
- 11 Collaborative Workspace Program; (10) Real Estate Services Technical Assistance; (11) the
- 12 Commonwealth Places Program; (12) Land Use Planning Grants; (13) Local Acquisitions for
- Natural Diversity (LAND) Grants; (14) Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness (MVP) Planning

- and Project Grants; and(15) any successor programs or comparable funding initiatives. The
- executive office shall not condition funding on the basis of a municipality's compliance or
- 16 noncompliance with this section.
