**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act requiring tax return disclosure to appear on a presidential primary ballot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 28 of chapter 53 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by adding the following new paragraph:- The state secretary shall not place
3 on the presidential primary ballot the name of any candidate who has not, at least 60 days in
4 advance of the presidential primary date, made public and readily available the candidate’s
5 federal income tax returns, as defined in section 6103(b)(1) of the United States internal revenue
6 code, for the immediately previous four years. The state secretary may promulgate regulations to
7 implement this paragraph.
