An Act relative to fluoride in water warnings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 8C the following section:-

3           Section 8D. The annual Consumer Confidence Report on water quality shall include the  
4 following language whenever the fluoride in drinking water is at or above 0.3 ppm:

5           The offspring of pregnant persons and bottle-fed babies are at risk of developmental  
6 neurotoxicity and damaged teeth from fluoride levels at or above 0.3 ppm;

7           Diabetics and those with kidney, thyroid, or inflammatory conditions are at risk of  
8 worsening their conditions from consumption of waters at or above 0.3 ppm.
