In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to the theft of graves.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary, no person shall
- 2 possess or sell, offer for sale or attempt to sell, or transfer or dispose of any monument,
- 3 gravestone, marker, or other structure, or any portion or fragment thereof, placed or designed for
- 4 a memorial of the dead, or any fence, railing, gate, plot delineator, or curb, knowing or having
- 5 reasonable cause to know that it has been unlawfully removed from a cemetery or burial ground.
