An Act to reduceeEmissions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 11F 1/2 of Chapter 25A of the general laws, as so appearing in the 2022 official
- 2 edition, is hereby amended by adding the following to the end of Section 11F 1/2 (e):
- 3 The department shall provide that for facilities generating useful thermal energy by using
- 4 eligible biomass technologies that also install an electrostatic precipitator or other emissions
- 5 control device, an alternative energy credit shall be earned for 1,706,000 British thermal units of
- 6 net useful thermal energy so as to improve air quality.
