An Act clarifying Group 4 retirement classification eligibility for utility maintenance workers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 3 of chapter 32, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby amended in the definition of Group 4 in paragraph (g) by striking out the
- 3 words "employees of a municipal gas or electric generating or distribution plant who are
- 4 employed as linemen, electric switchboard operators, electric maintenance men, steam engineers,
- 5 boiler operators, firemen, oilers, mechanical maintenance men, and supervisors of said
- 6 employees who shall include managers and assistant managers" and inserting in place thereof the
- 7 following words:-
- 8 employees of a municipal gas or electric generating or distribution plant who are
- 9 employed as linemen or line workers, electric switchboard operators, electric maintenance
- workers, substation technicians, meter installers, steam engineers, boiler operators, firemen or
- 11 firefighters, oilers, mechanical maintenance workers and supervisors of said employees who
- shall include managers and assistant managers.
- SECTION 2. Section 1 shall take effect upon enactment.
