### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act to promote employee ownership.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 63 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, after section 38NN, the

2 following new section:-

Section 3800. In determining the net income subject to tax under this chapter, a business corporation may deduct an amount equal to its earnings from capital gains from the sale of employer securities of a non-publicly traded business with fewer than 500 employees to an employee stock ownership plan, as defined in chapter 23D, that owns no less than 49 per cent of all outstanding employer securities issued by the business; provided, however, that the business corporation must be the sponsor of the employee stock ownership plan.
