**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to problem gambling and the public health trust fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 58 of chapter 23K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following sentences:-

3 The Department of Public Health shall make annual reports to the Speaker of the House,  
4 the President of the Senate, the Joint Committee on Public Health, the Joint Committee on  
5 Economic Development and Emerging Technologies on its treatment programs funded by the  
6 fund, including but not limited to: (i) the treatment programs funded by the Fund and the  
7 amounts they receive; (ii) the number of individuals served by each treatment program funded by  
8 the Fund, including whether they are new clients or continuing clients in the programs; (iii)  
9 demographic information of those served by treatment programs funded by the fund, including  
10 but not limited to the variables of sex, age, race, ethnicity, income, education, geography; and  
11 (iv) the outcomes obtained for individuals enrolled in treatment programs funded by the Fund.
