Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 Chapter 55 of the acts of 2003, is hereby amended by striking out the word "\$.50", in subsections
- 3 129(a) and 129(b), and inserting in place thereof the following word:- "\$1.00".
- 4 SECTION 2. Said section 129 is further amended by striking out the word "25", in
- 5 subsection 129(c), and inserting in place thereof the following word:- "12.5"
- 6 SECTION 3. Said section 129 is further amended by inserting after the words "shall be
- 7 paid to that city or town," in subsection 129(c), and inserting the following words:- "25 per cent
- 8 to a fire district that provides fire or public safety services to a port within a city or town that
- 9 provides ferry service"

- SECTION 4. Said section is further amended by striking out the word "75", in subsection
- 11 129(c), and inserting in place thereof the following word:- "62.5"
