Dear Superintendent Gray,

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health (Department) Division of Environmental Health Regulations and Standards (EHRS) conducted an inspection of the Northeastern Correctional Center on January 6, 2025, accompanied Michael Franco, Environmental Health and Safety Officer and Kevin Smith, Director of Maintenance, in accordance with Department regulations 105 CMR 451.000: Minimum Health and Sanitation Standards and Inspection Procedures for Correctional Facilities.

The inspection identified 107 total deficiencies: 44 deficiencies under the Required Standards (.100 and .200 series), 37 repeat deficiencies under the Required Standards, 13 deficiencies under the Recommended Standards (.300 series), 10 repeat deficiencies under the Recommended Standards, and 3 deficiencies under 105 CMR 451.402(B) (other conditions that may constitute a threat to health or safety).

#### Overview

Dear Superintendent Gray,

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The inspection identified 107 total deficiencies: 44 deficiencies under the Required Standards (.100 and .200 series), 37 repeat deficiencies under the Required Standards, 13 deficiencies under the Recommended Standards (.300 series), 10 repeat deficiencies under the Recommended Standards, and 3 deficiencies under 105 CMR 451.402(B) (other conditions that may constitute a threat to health or safety).

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Regulations and Standards (EHRS) has received your Plan of Correction in response to my inspection conducted on January 6, 2025. After review, the EHRS finds the plan addresses all the deficiencies noted with the following exceptions:

- 1. In regards to the issue of overcrowding, the EHRS appreciates the limitations of correctional facilities and the need to accommodate the ever-increasing population; however we remain concerned with the overcrowded conditions; and
- 2. Your Plan of Correction (POC) states the Gralton Hall basement project is receiving quotes for repairs and awaiting approval for capital funding. While the EHRS recognizes the complexities of managerial and budgetary constraints, we cannot approve any items that do not identify a reasonable time frame for repair. The EHRS remains concerned with the violations noted in regards to the Gralton Hall basement project and asks you provide a plan describing the interim measures you have implemented to ensure the health and safety of inmates and staff. In addition we ask to be kept apprised of the capital funding progress.

#### **Gralton Hall Basement Electrical Room**

105 CMR 451.353\* Interior Maintenance: Ceiling severely water damaged

Maintenance has cleaned the gutters on Gralton Hall, and this has stopped rainwater from getting into the area. Maintenance has cleaned the area, removed all existing damage and will also install a heavy-duty plastic under the damaged areas to prevent any further debris from falling. This will be completed by 5/1/25 and will be re-evaluated for further repair if needed.
