## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to investment in Massachusetts-based jobs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 3C of chapter 23A, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following 2 subsections:-
- 3 (e) Notwithstanding subsections (b) and (c), the EACC shall, by guideline or regulation,
- 4 establish an incentive program to encourage controlling businesses that locate their global or
- 5 national headquarters and executive operations within the commonwealth to hire and retain new,
- 6 permanent, full-time employees in the commonwealth, provided however that the business shall
- 7 not be required to invest in improvements to receive tax credits as part of the program
- 8 established under this subsection.
- 9 (f) The EACC shall give special consideration to the impact of investment and job growth
- in rural and seasonal communities within the commonwealth.

- SECTION 2. Section 3D of said chapter 23A, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 25, the word "and".
- SECTION 3. Said section 3D of said chapter 23A, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "project", in line 29, the following words:-
- ; and (viii) preference shall be given by the EACC to a controlling business that already
   bases its global or national headquarters and executive operations within the commonwealth
