**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act prohibiting exorbitant energy delivery charges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1F of Chapter 164 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
2 amended in Paragraph 7 after the word "safety" by inserting the following sentence:-

3 "The Department is authorized and directed to limit energy delivery charges on retail
4 customers' bills to not more than 50 percent of supply charges."
