An Act to remove the 10 MW net metering cap on each municipality.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Subsection (f) of section 139 of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2            2022 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words “The maximum amount of  
3            generating capacity eligible for net metering by a municipality or other governmental entity shall  
4            be 10 megawatts.”
