An Act relative to handicap parking access for individuals with autism.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 The ninth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2014 Official Edition, by inserting after the first sentence the following:-
- 3 An individual diagnosed with 1 of the autism spectrum disorders or the parent or
- 4 guardian of an individual diagnosed with 1 of the autism spectrum disorders may be issued a
- 5 placard, provided that the parent or guardian shall only use such placard when transporting the
- 6 individual diagnosed with 1 of the autism spectrum disorders.
