In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act to support police recruitment and retention.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6, Section 116 of the general laws is hereby amended by adding the following 2 new section:-
- 3 Section 116K. The municipal police training committee shall, not less than annually,
- 4 assess the workforce status of policing in the commonwealth, with regard to its adequacy,
- 5 diversity, and equity, and shall make recommendations for actions necessary for the recruitment
- and retention of law enforcement officers to meet these goals. The results of said assessment,
- 7 together with such recommendations, shall be filed with the executive office of public safety and
- 8 homeland security, the joint committee on public safety and homeland security, the House and
- 9 Senate Committees on Ways and Means, and the clerks of the House and Senate, whom shall
- post them electronically for public inspection, not later than December 31.
